LAST NEWS: CALL FOR PARTICIPANTS TO THE YOUTH MOBILITY IN DUBROVNIK

The **"Building future-looking collaborative work environments in rural areas"** youth mobility will take place in Dubrovnik in Croatia between September 20th and September 25th.

Partners are recruiting 18 young people from Bulgaria, Croatia, Italy, Norway, Poland, Slovenia aged between 18 and 29.

Participants must:

- understand and be able to work in English language;
- be open to learn and collaborative;
- must demonstrate motivation to take part of the transnational activity.

Preference will be given to young people who:

- demonstrate a passion for entrepreneurship, virtual reality, co-working business, health and personal care, green economy, ICT and technology
- who are currently out of work and education.

All costs will be covered by the project; meals and a shared accommodation will be provided for all participants.

ABOUT THE PROJECT

CRAFT - Coworking in Rural Areas to prepare young people for Future Trends is an Erasmus+ initiative that aims at supporting young people in rural areas to develop their employability, entrepreneurship, and preparedness for the jobs of the future through coworking.

CRAFT activities that will help achieve these goals are:

- an online training programme for builders of future-looking collaborative with three modules:
(1) Career Skills for the Future; (2) Entrepreneurship skills with a focus on the areas of personal care and health, green economy and STEAM; (3) Managing co-working spaces in rural areas.
- a 3D virtual world platform with 7 original game-based learning scenarios
- an international learning activity for young people
- Hackathons involving young people, counsellors and co-working managers.
