## YOUTH MOBILITY IN DUBROVNIK

The "Building future-looking collaborative work environments in rural areas" youth mobility took place in Dubrovnik in Croatia between September 19th and September 26th, 2021.

17 motivated young people from Bulgaria, Croatia, Italy, Norway, Poland, Slovenia aged between 18 and 29 and interested about the topics of the project attended the training as well as the collateral activities, which included visits to collaborative working spaces, social activities, exhibitions and euro-dinners.

The participants were introduced to coworking, green, digital and social jobs through the training modules, developed by the partnership and through practical activities, exploiting Design Thinking and Lego@Serious Play methodologies. They also had the chance to pilot the CRAFT 3D virtual world, with game-bases scenarios, in which learners can test their knowledge.

# YOUTH PROJECTS

Youth were divided into three groups and their collaborative work resulted in three ideas, prototypes and business models for collaborative working spaces in the following sectors:

- 1) green economy
- 2) social jobs
- 3) IT and digital jobs



## MULTIPLIER EVENT

The event **"Lessons learned and steps ahead: ideas and prototypes of future-looking collaborative work environments"** took place on September 24th, 2021 in Dubrovnik. It saw the participation of 42 local organizations, of the partners and of young people participating to the C1 activity.

Projects' objectives and activities as well as the EU contribution and support were presented, together with the IO1 – Training programme for builders of future-looking collaborative work environments in rural areas and IO2 Educational 3D virtual world.

C1 activity results, coworking ideas, physical prototypes and business models were presented by young people through a pitch. Local stakeholders were invited to ask them questions and to look at projects more in details; moreover, all participants were involved in a brainstorming session to discuss the quality, effectiveness and peculiarities of the three business ideas.
